CLASSES

HORSEMANSHIP 1 – For the green horse and rider already comfortable in the snaffle bit along with aged horses needing continued work. This is the first stage of progressing into the bridle with all basic movements introduced. All levels of riders - no matter what discipline - will benefit. The class features strictly dry work - no cattle. All maneuvers stress the vaquero style of riding and are appropriate for horses from first level snaffle to experienced bridle horses. Hackamore horses welcome.

3 Sessions 9:00-12:00 each day \$700

HORSEMANSHIP 2 – The next phase in the development of the versatile bridle horse. Horsemanship 2 introduces the rider to working the horse in the hackamore and beyond. The class involves working cattle and ranch roping so that all aspects in preparing the bridle horse-in-the-making are addressed.

3 Sessions 1:30-4:30 each day \$700 plus cattle charges to be divided evenly

THE CLINIC MAY BE FULL, please call or email before sending deposit

COSTS - Class cost is \$700 per class, with cattle charges for H2. Deposit of \$200 guarantees a spot in the clinic. This is a non-refundable and non-transferable deposit. The remainder (\$500) is due by June 5, 2018. If not paid by this date, the spot will be given to the next person on the waiting list.

PARTICIPATION - Participating in a class gives you 3 days of 3 hours with your horse and Buck and includes watching the other class. Buck encourages all riders to watch the class that they are not enrolled in and will refer to both classes in his teachings. He appreciates hard work.

STALLS - Indoor stalls are available through fairgrounds and outdoor pens are available through sponsors. See Pens & Stall Information on website.

CAMPING - Dry Camping at the arena will be allowed for participants in the clinic, no reservation required. Fairgrounds has RV camping located in the EXPO RV Park. For reservations call 541-585-1569.
